You may direct your gift to a specific fund in support of any special interests you may have or you can direct your gift to the area of greatest need. Undesignated donations are placed in the Community Fund which benefits a range of projects.

## Our Mission

The mission of the **South Cariboo Community Enhancement Foundation is to Support, Promote, Advance and Encourage** all community members of the South Cariboo.

This is accomplished in the following ways:

- **Education:** by establishing scholarship funds and providing funding for specific educational endeavours
- **Community Support:** by promoting programs that directly benefit the needy and assist in alleviating human suffering and poverty
- **Sports:** by encouraging amateur sports and recreation in our community
- **Arts & Cultural Activities:** by supporting all forms of art and cultural activity
- **Preservation:** by promoting the preservation of lands and buildings of historical or environmental value as well as protection of the environment through hands-on projects, as well as through courses and seminars directed at educating the public

## Gift Opportunities

### DIRECT GIFTS

Money, securities, or appreciated property may be transferred to the SCCEF. The donor receives a tax deduction based on the value at the time of transfer. The donor will not be subject to capital gains tax on any accrued appreciation.

### WILL BEQUESTS

Donors may provide gifts through a will for a stated sum or a percentage of your estate.

### DEFERRED GIFTS

Deferred gifts provide a lifetime income to the donor or designee(s). Upon death, the residue of the gift becomes the property of the SCCEF.

### LIFE INSURANCE

By naming the SCCEF as irrevocable beneficiary of a life insurance policy, donors receive an immediate tax deduction. Premiums paid thereafter are deductible from income tax.

### MEMORIALS

Gifts honouring individuals are an appropriate way of indicating one's care and concern.
